REGULATIONS FOR MCLENNAN PUBLIC CEMETERY

The cost for a plot is \$200 plus G.S.T.

1. All monuments shall be of stone, marble, granite or aluminium alloy markers. No wooden monuments shall be placed on a cemetery plot.
2. All monuments or markers shall be placed at the head of the plot on solid ground and shall be in line with other monuments in that section of the cemetery. No foot markers are permitted.
3. No more than four cremations per plot. With the exception of the burial of the first cremation in a plot, the cost for other crematoriums will be \$100 each.
4. Full length grave covers of any construction shall not be allowed.
5. All foundations for erecting monuments shall be made of concrete and must not be less than six inches around the complete base of the monument and must be at level with the surface of the ground.
6. No monument heavier than 95 kilograms (200 lbs) shall be installed at any time.
7. No fence, nor railings, wall, stone copings shall be erected on any lot.
8. Sale of family or double lots is discontinued, except if cremation takes place.
9. Flowers and decorations are permitted at the time of burial, but they may be removed by the caretaker if and when they become weathered and objectionable to the general appearance of the cemetery.
10. Permission must be given by caretaker to plant trees or shrubs (no flower beds).
11. A burial permit is required to bury, cremate or otherwise dispose of the body of a deceased person.

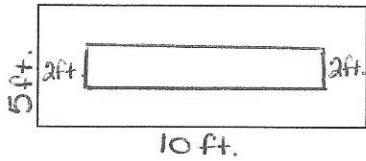
Permits are printed by some funeral homes on behalf of the family when funeral service arrangements are being made. Burial permits may also be obtained from a hospital registrar.

A cemetery will not consent to a burial, nor a crematorium to a cremation, without the prescribed burial permit.

Plots

Plots along the west fence (row N) are designated for the burial of cremations only. Each plot is 3 ft. wide and has a 2 ft. buffer around it for a total width of 5ft.



All other cemetery plots are 5ft. wide and 10 ft. in length. Only the bottom 8ft. of the plot shall have the earth removed from it, so that the top 2ft. has no ground disturbance and a monument can be placed on it thereafter. A standard hole is 3ft. x 8ft. for caskets with the exception of fibre glass caskets the hole needs to be 3 ½ ft. x 8ft.
